

Camp Fees

Camp fees include T-shirt, patch and program materials.

Day Camp Staff

Day Camps are operated by council volunteers and parents selected to be on Day Camp Staff, as well as council professional staff. Every staff member is trained to ensure your son will have a safe, fun and exciting camp. Contact your district executive to become part of your district day camp staff.

Transportation—Supervision

Each Pack must arrange its own daily transportation to and from camp. Chaperones must be provided daily. (Remember: 2 deep leadership). The chaperone MUST stay the whole time with their unit or arrange for someone to replace them.

Cancellation

If inclement weather occurs that day's program may be cancelled for the safety of the boys. Please make sure that an emergency contact phone number is listed on the Annual Health form.

Meals

Please bring a sack lunch, that does not need refrigeration, for each day. Fresh water is available daily.

Registration

A Cub Scout should ideally register with his Pack. You are always welcome to attend with your parent, if a Pack is not attending. A copy of the Annual Health and Medical Record form MUST be completed for EVERYONE prior to attending camp. It should be turned in at the time of registration. **The registration process is not complete until ALL health forms have been turned in at the council office.** Gold Card discount is available on registration fees. Siblings

Parents who are chaperones are welcome to bring siblings. The cost will be \$10 per sibling per day. Add an additional \$5 if the sibling would like a patch and t-shirt.
