

General Information on all High Adventure Activities

Leadership: All crews must have one adult leader at all times. That adult must be 21 years of age. Camp provides a guide for your trip who is at least 18 years of age.

Crew Size: 6-12 per crew including adults (for river trips & backpacking)
6-8 per crew including adults for Boundary Waters.
All treks must have a minimum of six participants.

Age Requirement: All participants must be 13 years of age by January 1, 2010

Swimming Requirements: All participants for River Trips & Boundary Waters must be swimmers. All participants will be tested upon arrival at camp. NOTE: For those doing whitewater, it is highly recommended that they have earned the canoeing merit badges.

Camp Provides: Shelter, stoves, cook sets, cooking utensils, canoes, canoe trailers, life vests, paddles, climbing equipment, food, water purifiers, maps, permits, leaders information packet.

You Provide: Personal camping equipment i.e.; sleeping bag, eating utensils & proper clothing for the High Adventure trip you selected.

Fees: \$100.00 deposit is required to reserve your trip. A non-refundable, \$50.00 deposit per person required by April 1, 2010 to hold your date & High Adventure activity. The balance of the fees are due by May 1st.. NOTE: One adult is free per troop, crew or post, additional adults pay the same fee as youth participants. Gold card discounts do NOT apply to High Adventure trips.

Medicals: All participants must have an Annual Health form signed by a doctor within the last 12 months.

Custom Trips: Can be arranged for an additional fee

Weeks of Operation: June 13-19; June 20-26; June 27-July 3; July 4-10; July 11-17; July 18-24;
July 25-31 For 3 day treks - pick your 3 consecutive days from June 13 - July 31.

Permits: Permits are required for Boundary Waters. Reservations must be made by April 1, 2010.
