All Troops, Webelos Dens, and Venture Crews are invited to attend the Clear Water District 2012 Klondike Derby. Troops & Crews will participate in a variety of stations rotating throughout the day to test their skills in a variety of areas.

Rotations include: *Lumberjack Knack, Smoke or Fire, Norwegian Skis, Geocaching, Snowshoe Races, How High? How Far, Heartbreak Hill, Take Aim, Don't Feed the Bears*

Bring your sled and gear from the list below, as well as plenty of warm clothing for the day.

Head south on Hwy 37, turn at Langdell Rd. and look for signage. Camp Davidson is about 9 miles south of Eau Claire.

Fire starting gear

First-aid kit

Pocketknife & Totin' Chit

Flashlight

Rope or twine

Paper and Pencil

Blanket

Canteen with water or water bottle (2 quarts per Scout)

Mug or warm liquids container for each Scout

Trash bag

1 item of value to leave in the Geocache. All Troops will get another item of value back.

Proper cold weather clothing including multiple layers, hat and gloves, and warm boots/footwear for each Scout. No Tennis Shoes! Bring two extra pairs of socks.

Meals and necessary cook gear for Saturday supper if staying overnight.

Troops should bring all water for the weekend, one gallon per person.

Sunday breakfast will be provided. Add \$3 per person to your registration fee.
