

Chippewa Valley Council Scoutmasters:

Please share with your Troop advancement chairs and any boys currently involved in the Life to Eagle process.

Effective September 2011, the Eagle Scout Board of Review process will be changing in the Chippewa Valley Council.

Previously Eagle Scout candidates selected their own Board of Review participants. BSA National Advancement Policy calls for Board of Review participants to be selected by the District Boy Scout Advancement committee.

Beginning this Fall, Board of Review participants will be selected by the Eagle Scout candidate's District Life to Eagle Counselor (This is a new position within the District). When a Scout has completed all requirements for the Eagle Scout rank, he should work with his counselor to schedule a date for his Board of Review. Once the date is scheduled the District Life to Eagle Counselor will find 3 to 6 individuals who are knowledgeable of the Eagle Scout process to sit on the Board of Review.

There is a need for more individuals who are interested in being Board of Review members. Please contact the Scout Service Center or your District Boy Scout Advancement chairperson with any questions or to have your name placed on a list of Board of Review members.
