## ***Camp Phillips***

### **For ALL Boy Scout Troops and Webelos I and II Dens**

#### **What Is It?**

Webelos Woods is an outdoor experience designed to introduce Webelos Scouts and their parents to the thrilling Scouting adventures that lay ahead and helps make the transition into Boy Scouting exciting. The weekend is filled with fun activities, intriguing demonstrations, and plenty of outdoor excitement. Webelos Dens will rotate through a variety of program areas where Boy Scout Troops demonstrate Boy Scout skills. An emphasis is put on hands-on activities.

#### **Who Can Participate?**

All Webelos I and II Scouts and parents are invited to participate for the weekend event. Boy Scout Troops are also highly encouraged to attend and to put on a program area for Webelos Scouts to participate in.

#### **Where?**

The event is held at Camp Phillips (Boy Scout Side). Scouts will have the chance to participate in program throughout Camp. Webelos Scouts will camp in Boy Scout campsites, and have the chance to use the tent-cabins if they wish. Buildings will also be available for sleeping in the case of inclement weather. Boy Scout Troops should plan on bringing tents to use in a campsite.

#### **What is the cost?**

Cost for the weekend is \$15 per Webelos Scout, Boy Scout, or leader/parent. Cost includes a patch and three meals: Saturday lunch and supper, and Sunday breakfast. All Troops and Dens **MUST** pre-register by submitting the enclosed form to the Scout Service Center by Tuesday, November 2<sup>nd</sup>.

#### **What about adult leadership?**

Each Webelos den attending must have two-deep leadership. It is the leader's responsibility to participate with their den throughout the weekend. Troops also must have proper two-deep leadership.

#### **What to Bring?**

##### **Webelos Dens and Boy Scout Troops**

- Plate, cup, and silverware for the weekend (either disposal or metal; washing facilities will be available)
- Sleeping Bag
- Sleeping Pad ***New this Year: Each Adult Cabin Furnished with Mattresses***
- Toiletry items
- Jug of water for your group to use for the weekend
- Water bottle or thermos
- Flashlight
- Scout uniform

- Several snack items for your Webelos den to use for cracker barrel Saturday night

- Clothing for the weather! Please remember that November weather in Wisconsin can be unpredictable and that Scouts and leaders will be camping outside. Proper attire may include:

- Warm jacket
- Boots
- Stocking hat and gloves
- Wool socks
- Second set of clothing

\*If you have questions about dressing for the weather, contact your area's Boy Scout leader for suggestions.

- Items to provide a cracker barrel for the Webelos den camping with you on Saturday

### **Notes for Boy Scout Troops**

Thank you for helping to put this event on for the fourth year. It would not be possible without the assistance of our Troops. There are several things that we ask of our participating Troops:

- Put on a program area during the day on Saturday. Webelos dens will rotate through your area every half-hour from 9 am – 12 noon and 1 pm – 3:30 pm. The program area should be “hands-on” and feature a skill or activity that the Webelos will have a chance to do as Boy Scouts. See below for suggestions, but feel free to be creative as well!

- Help support the Webelos dens that share a campsite with you on Saturday night. We are asking that tent-cabins be reserved for Webelos youth and leaders. Troops should plan on sleeping in tents. This can be a tremendous opportunity for your youth and adult leaders to meet Scouts who could bridge into your unit this Spring.

- Saturday night Cracker Barrel: Each campsite will have a cracker barrel on Saturday night. Each Troop should plan on providing snacks for this. Webelos dens have been encouraged to bring snack items as well. In the spirit of Scouting though, "Be Prepared!"

- Troops are invited to arrive on Friday night to set up their campsites and program areas. Please indicate on the registration form if you will be checking in on Friday or Saturday.

## **Program Area Ideas:**

### **Webelos Activity Badges:**

\_\_\_ **Handyman:** - Any of the requirements 4 – 10, 12, and/or 17

\_\_\_ **Outdoorsman:** - Any of the requirements

\_\_\_ **Readyman:** - demonstrate and teach basic first aid skills

(**First Aid**) - make a personal first aid kit

\_\_\_ **Scientist:** - Any of the requirements

### **Basic Scout Skills:**

\_\_\_ **Rope Yard:** - displays of commonly used knots

- show how to tie basic knots

- make rope and/or whip rope ends

\_\_\_ **Pioneering:** - have display of types of lashing

build monkey bridge and other camp gadgets (use correct lashings)

- show how to lash

- have Webelos Scouts try a monkey bridge

\_\_\_ **Model Campsite:** - set up a model campsite using BSA guidelines

- show tent areas, dining areas, cooking areas, etc

- have Webelos Scouts set up a tent

\_\_\_ **Compass:** - show how to use a compass and maps

- show how to read a map

- show how to use compass with a map

- have Webelos Scouts do a short, simple compass course

\_\_\_ **Maze:** - construct a maze .... Stakes and ropes

- have Webelos Scouts see if they can do the maze

\_\_\_ **Other:** - please list event and what will take place
